## Schedule

9:00 am to 2:00 pm Program

Twos-Fours

Parents of Twos have the option of choosing a T/TH, M/W/F, or M-F program. Parents of Threes & Fours may choose a M/W/F or M-F program. Children should arrive between 8:45 and 9:00am and must be picked up between 1:45-2:00pm. Late fees will be charged for pick-up after 2:00pm.

Full Day Program

Infants-Fours
7:00-9:00 am & 2:00-6:00 pm

Our Full Day program is for our families needing care beyond our 9-2 school day. Children may arrive as early at 7:00 am and stay as late as 6:00 pm. The additional cost of this program includes full care on some school holidays (excluding major holidays) and is a year-round program. A breakfast snack and afternoon snack are included in the tuition. Late fees will be charged for pick-up after 6:00pm.

### Guidelines

Please dress your child in socks and closed-toed shoes (no sandals) and play clothes appropriate for weather conditions. Children enjoy time on the playground twice daily, unless weather dictates otherwise. All children should keep a change of clothes in a plastic bag at school. We ask that you put your child's name on all belongings-lunch container, clothes, nap mats, coats, hats, etc. Please do not allow children to bring personal toys from home.

#### Lunch

Children must bring a lunch. Lunch boxes should be plainly marked on the outside with your child's name.
