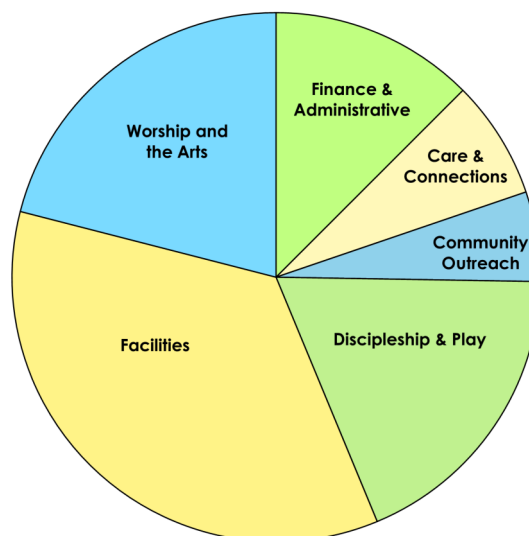

Community Engagement	\$93,292
Care and Connections	\$123,526
Discipleship and Play	\$314,203
Facilities	\$599,525
Finance & Administrative	\$212,800
Total	\$1,700,486

Financial Priorities:

- Fund ministries with a balanced budget
- Fund building costs and save for known future building expenses
- Give staff overdue compensation increases
- Fund Pastor search expenses

An increase of about \$125,000 in annual giving to CCPC's general fund will allow us to support our ministries in 2026. The increase is primarily needed to cover the rising costs of maintaining our building and increases to personnel expenses.
